THEME:

The plan, the promise, and the means of righteousness by faith

Read Romans 3:21 - 31 and consider these questions.

1. According to verse 25-26, why did God “pass over former sins” (2 Pet. 3:9, Rom 2:4) and why might this be so important to the argument Paul is making in Romans?
2. What does Paul mean in verse 31 when he says that we now uphold the law?

2. How should 3:23 inform our view of ourselves? Why is this important to think through?
3. How should 3:23 inform our view and expectation of those around us? Why is this important to think through?
