Romans 4:3, 10, 16, 20-25

THEME:

Unpacking the nature of faith through Abraham's Story

Read Romans 4:1-25 and consider these questions.

1. Why does Paul establish Abraham as a model for how one achieves righteousness before God?
2. Why might the language of being Abraham's offspring be important to the church that Paul was writing this letter to?

Discuss these next questions designed to help us better know God, self, and others.

1. In what ways is your view of God's faithfulness strengthened? (v. 23-24)
2. How does it make you feel knowing that God's promise to Abraham was also a promise made to you? (v. 16-17)
3. How could v. 7-8 challenge us to think about those we live near, work with, or know, who don't know Jesus?
